Description of Rides: (All rides are very scenic)

Ride #1 - Easy, flat ride to Walker Lake, approximately 2-3 hours

Ride #2 - Moderate ride – east side of ranch with some hills. Approximately 3-4 hours.

Ride #3 - Ridge Ride - mountainous ride recommended for experienced riders with well conditioned horses - approximately 3-4 hours

NOTICE

1. Alcoholic beverages or smoking ARE NOT permitted on the Ranch.
2. No stallions, please.
3. All minors (under 16) to be accompanied by adult (both to ride on same ride)
4. **Maximum number of riders approximately 100** - being divided into smaller groups dependent on which group you choose (See descriptions above)

Some trail etiquette reminders:

1. Please keep with your group
2. Keep horses to walk, slow gait, or slow trot when necessary to catch up with group or pass.
No running on trails, please.
3. Let person know when you are passing.
4. Please do not crowd riders in front of you. One horse length between riders strongly recommended.
5. Please place red warning ribbon on tails of horses that may kick.
6. Please be courteous. We appreciate well-mannered horses.

Note: Family, friends and other non-riders are very welcome to attend the BBQ and Tour
